THE EVENT



Join us this summer for the Brothers Redevelopment Paint-A-Thon, an event that has become one of the state's largest volunteer events serving seniors.

Created in 1978, the Paint-A-Thon is a free service for elderly homeowners who need their homes painted, but cannot afford a commercial paint job.

Volunteer painting teams are essential to the event's success. Our valuable volunteers donate their time and energy to paint the homes of these deserving homeowners.

You can help continue the tradition by recruiting a team of 8 to 10 people (from your office, church, civic group, family, neighborhood, etc...) and signing-up to paint a home on August 7 or 14 with Aug. 21 serving as a potential rain date.

YOUR JOB

Provide all painting equipment for the day, including scrapers, drop cloths, wire brushes, paint brushes, rollers, pans and ladders.

As team coordinator you will:

- *Contact the senior whose home you will paint
- *Inspect the home and allow for any advance preparation work
- *Agree to finish painting the house, including final cleanup
- *Publicize your team's effort at every opportunity (company newsletter, etc.)

Paint-A-Thon projects are active work sites and we require direct parental / guardian supervision for volunteers less than fourteen years of age.

And remember, your team has the option of nominating a senior you know to receive this wonderful gift.

OUR PART

- *Ensure homeowner meets income guidelines
 - *Screen property for need and size of project (easily completed in one day by volunteers)
 - *Confer with homeowner on colors, determine quantity of paint required per house
 - *Assign a home that matches the skill and size of your team
 - *Mail information to team coordinators by July 25, containing all pertinent information on the home and homeowner
 - *Have paint, putty, caulk, stir sticks and yard sign at each home on the day of painting
 - *Inspect the completed home and pick up unused supplies
 - *Promote the event (including use of pictures) in local media outlets
